2023/24 Season Membership Fees and Registration to Sport link.

Teams need to be registered with the KNVB in early June, thus by 31 May we require everyone to register their intent of returning next year. Failure to inform us by this deadline may incur a re-registering fee in addition to the annual subscription. All membership fees need to be paid by June 15th. Please use <http://internationalfc.nl/returning> to indicate your intention to play next season.

To register, please make sure to fill in the questionnaire at **internationalfc.nl/returning** to confirm you will be continuing next season, along with the size for training top and tracksuit that you'd like to request.

This must be done by latest May 31st. After this date you will be removed from Sport link, and we will presume you will not be continuing in the new season.

Players that have not paid will not be allowed to train or play until fees paid.

All players/parents will be required to pay the follow fees for season 2023/24:

Youth fee: €275.00. (Including tracksuit and training top)

Adult fee: €275.00. including tracksuit and warm up shirt etc.
